# **EDUCATION PROGRAMS**

### **KNOWLEDGE IS POWER**

This presentation focuses on Child Sexual Abuse Prevention Program for Children and Adults. Children and adolescents are taught body safety, to whom and how to report abuse, and empower children to have a voice and speak up. Adults will learn more about how to talk to children about body safety at home, how to spot the red flags, and what to do if they suspect a child is a victim.

#### **LOVE146 NOT A NUMBER**

This human trafficking prevention program is geared to 12-18 year olds to educate teens on what is human trafficking and how to avoid risky situations in which they may become a victim. Teens will also discuss healthy and unhealthy relationships, and learn skills to keep themselves and others safe from vulnerabilities most teen face daily.

## STEWARDS OF CHILDREN BY DARKNESS TO LIGHT

This prevention education program for adults focuses on how to talk to children about body safety, and reporting suspected abuse of a child or teen.

### **PROFESSIONAL TRAININGS**

This training is directed to those who are mandated reporters and other professionals. The focus of this presentation is education on child abuse and child sex trafficking prevention, identification, and reporting measures.

All of these trainings and presentations are offered FREE of charge by trained Gingerbread House staff. They are offered in person or virtually. ## **DID YOU KNOW**

The cost of a Child Advocacy Center (CAC) multidisciplinary investigation is approximately \$1,000 less than the cost of a non-CAC child abuse investigation on a case-by-case basis?

The Gingerbread House has served 13,040 child victims since opening its doors 23 years ago.

By this conservative estimate alone, the Gingerbread House has saved the NWLA community over \$13 MILLION since opening its doors in June, 1998!

All services are offered free of charge to child victims so that no child is ever turned away due to a family's inability to pay for services.
